- As highlighted by the Treasurer, the club has also had a solid year financially, while still coming out of a number of challenging years, being reactive to the ongoing public health crisis. The club had both new and returning sponsors, and received funding from the NZRU through the Silver Lake deal.
- The club has also been able to enable success with succession planning at all levels, retaining a strong coaching lineup, having returning players complimented by successful recruitment and depth of support on Executive. This has allowed for more teams in competition, such as an additional side in the Men's Reserve Grade.
